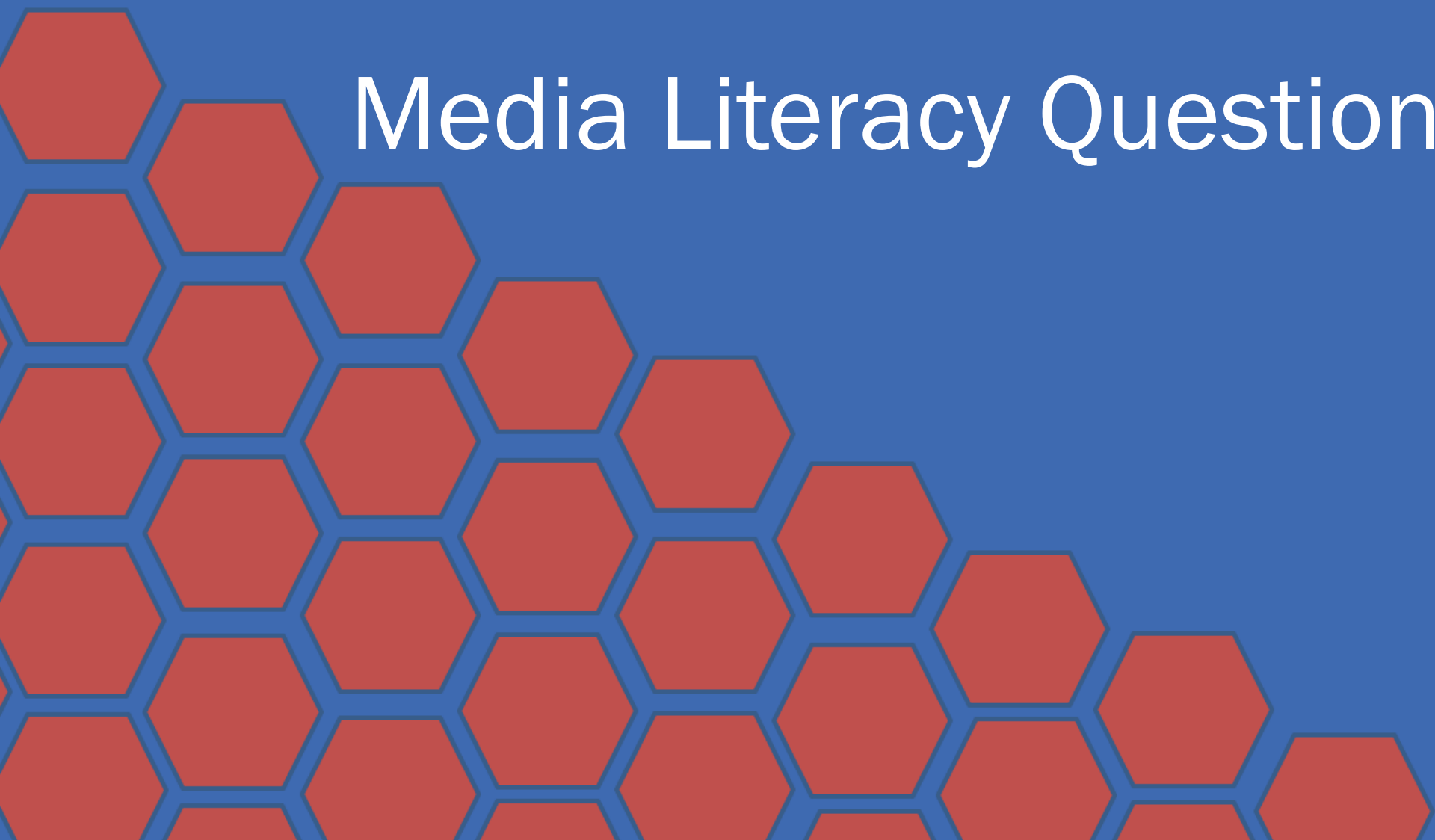


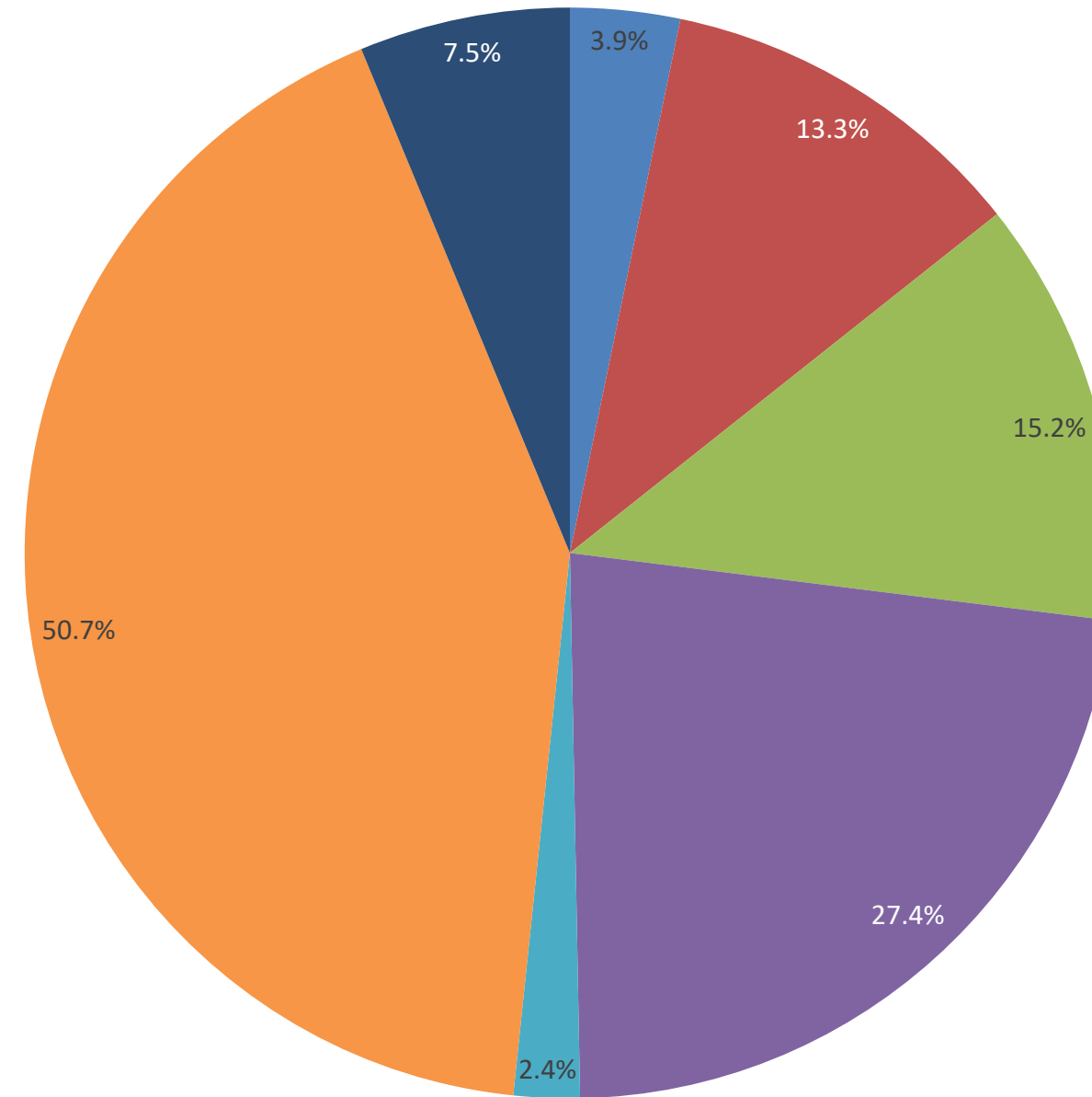

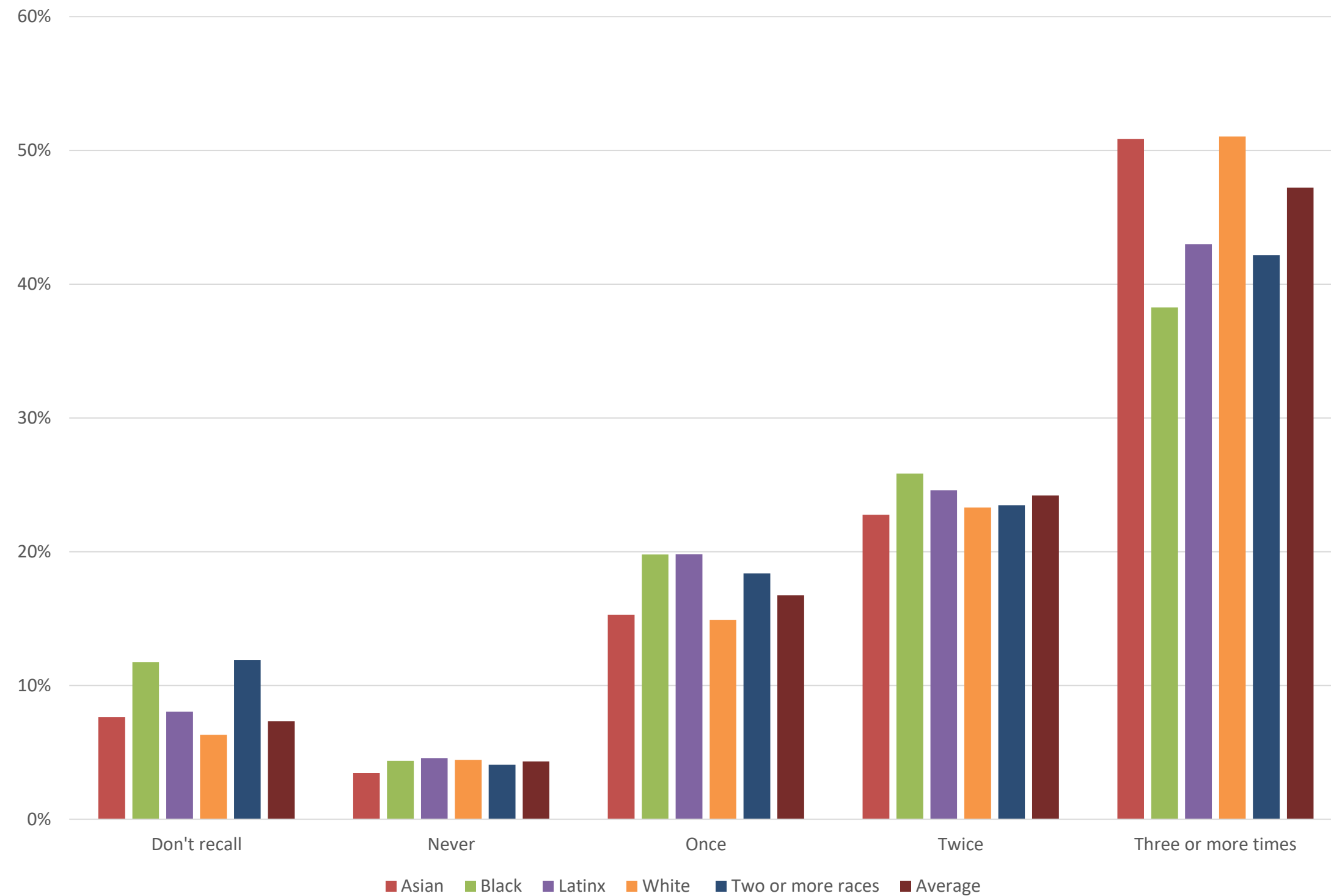
# 2019 Democracy Schools Student Assessment Participants by Race/Ethnicity (N=3,904)



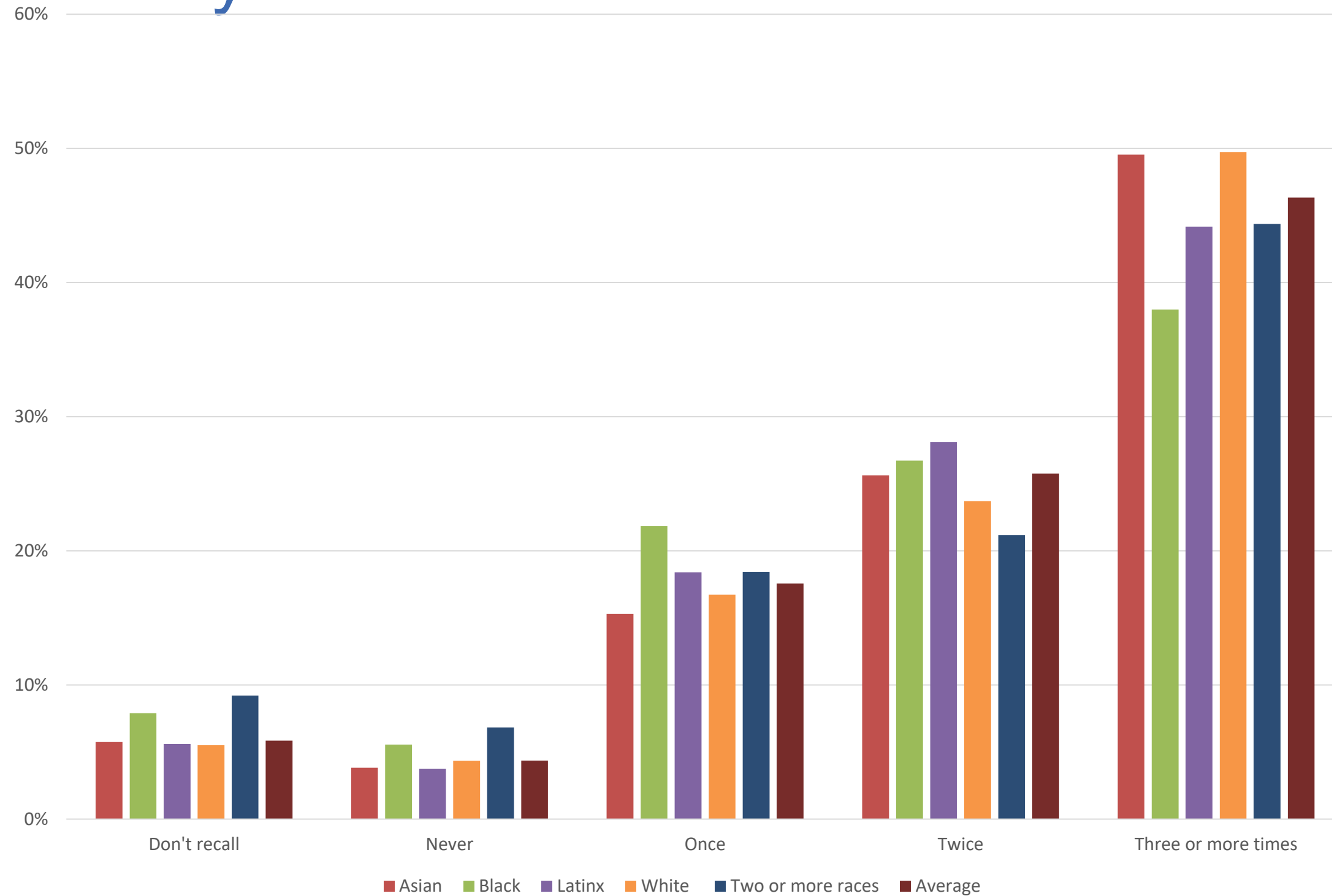
■ American Indian ■ Asian ■ Black ■ Latinx ■ Pacific Islander ■ White ■ Two or more races



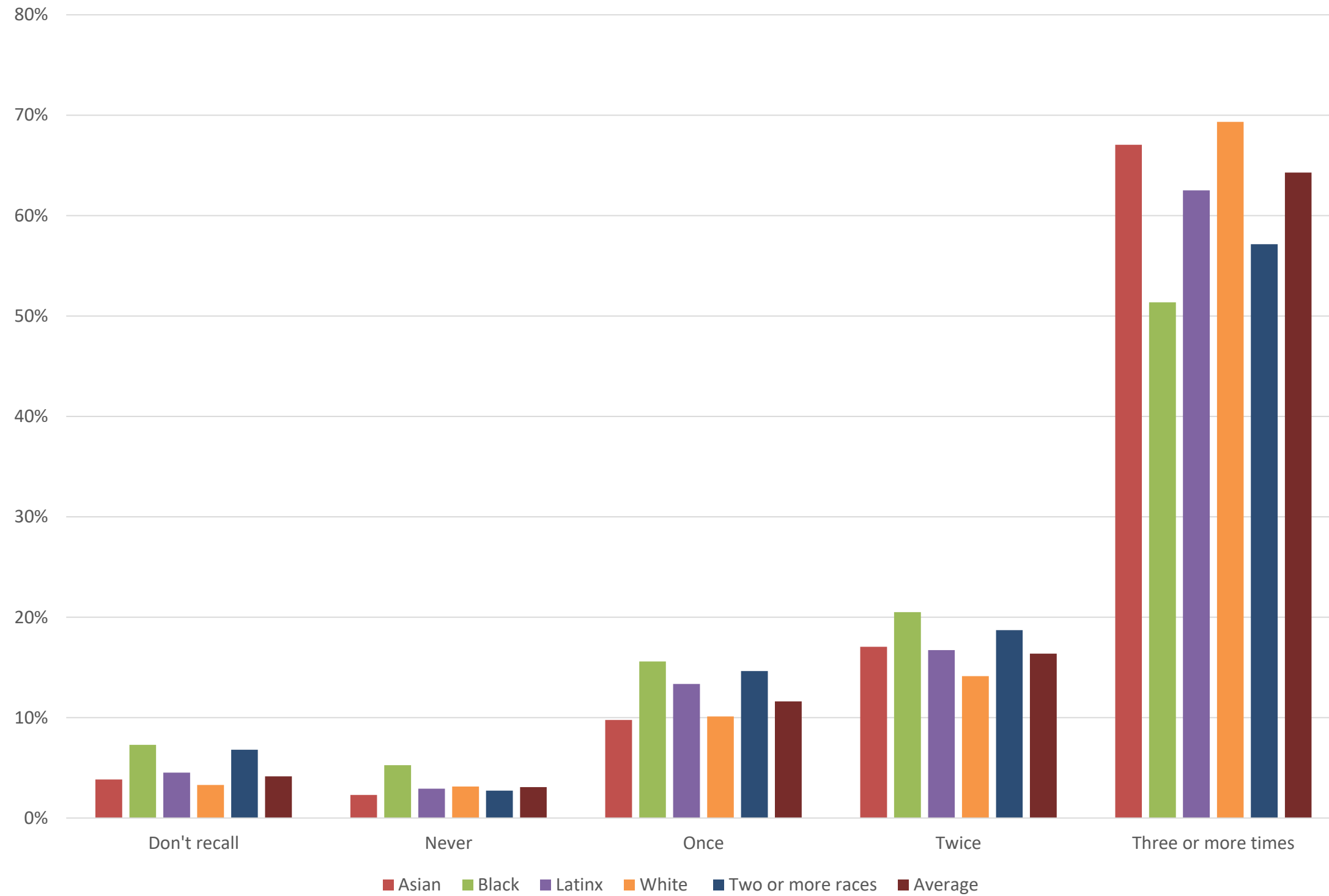

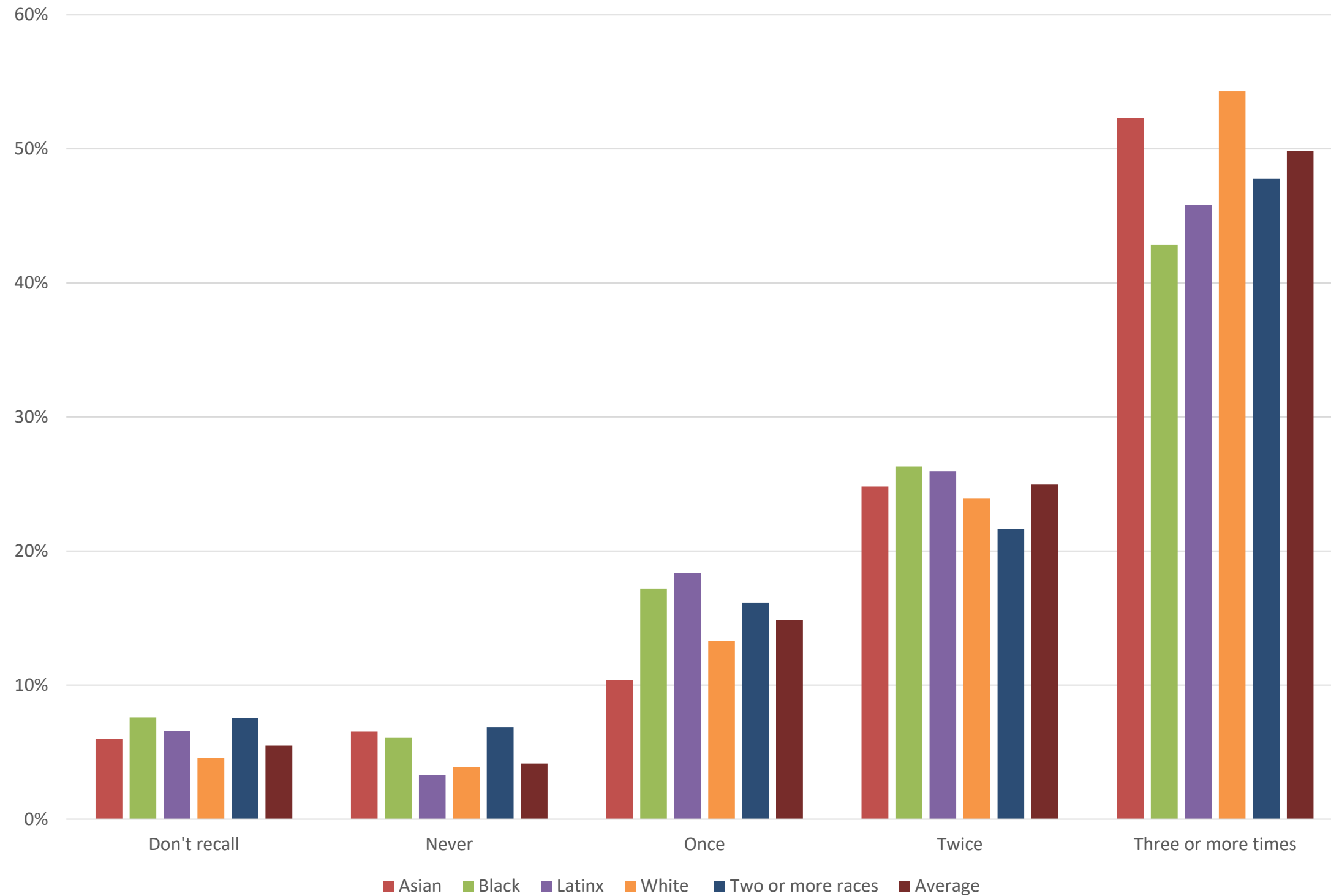
# In my high school classes I have learned how to find different perspectives and multiple sources of information about a current event or community issue.



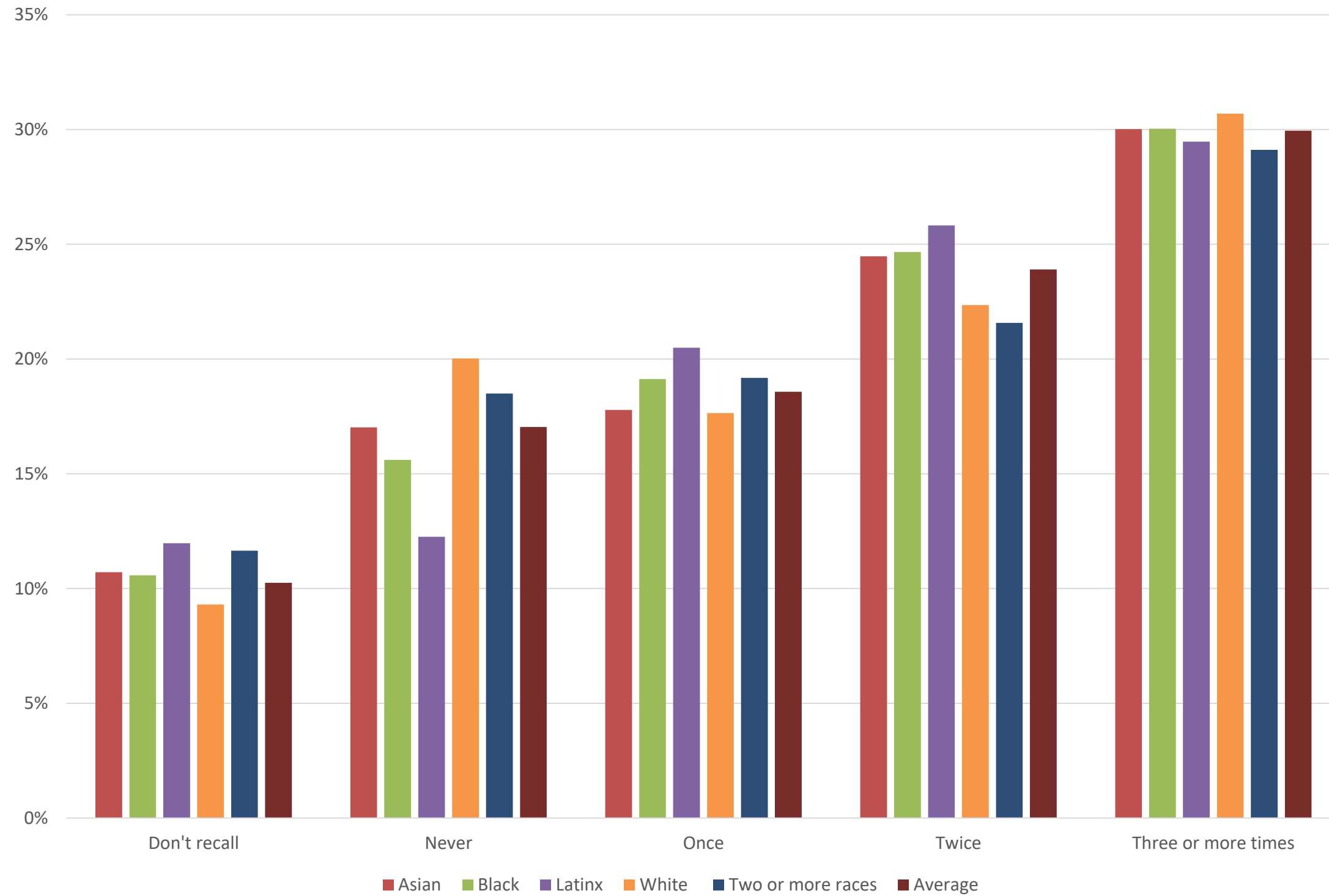
# In my high school classes I have researched or searched for information online.



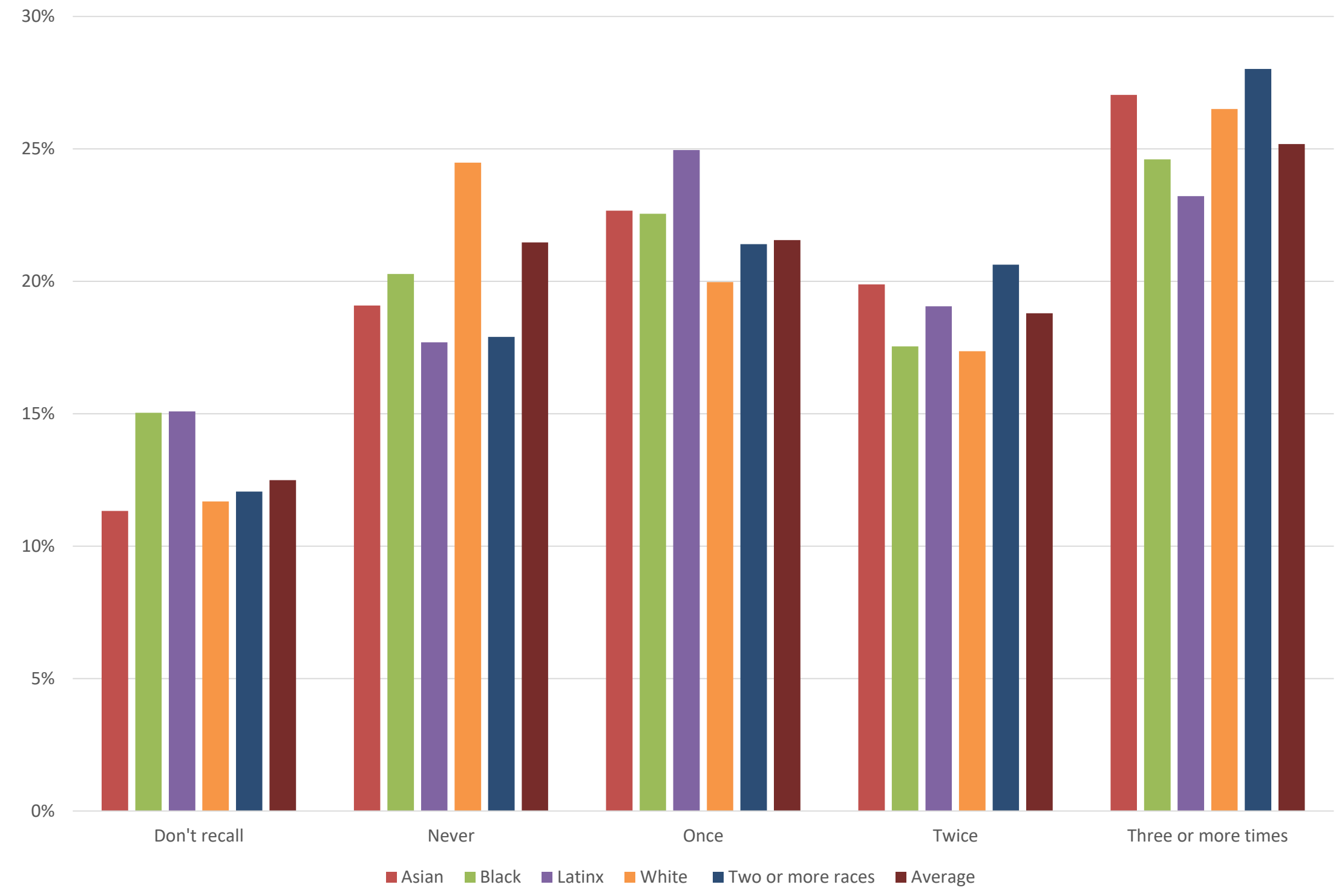
# In my high school classes I have discussed how to tell if the information you find online is trustworthy.



# In my high school classes I have discussed how to effectively share your opinion on social or political issues online.

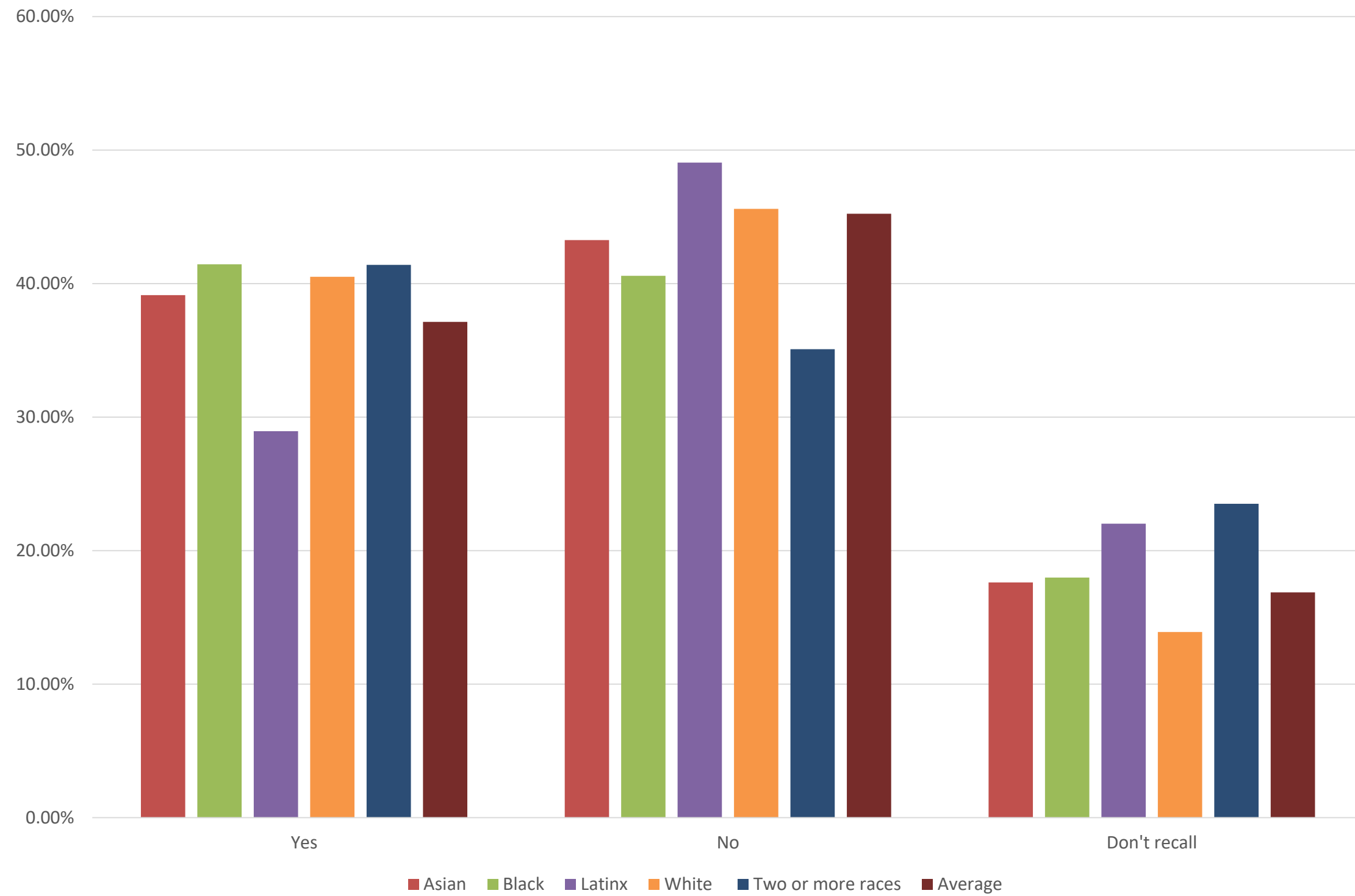


# In my high school classes I have created and shared something on the Internet related to a societal issue
