

McCormick Foundation Launches Illinois Tornado Relief Effort

WGN Radio, WGN TV, Chicago Tribune and Hoy Join Forces with McCormick to Raise Funds for Communities Reeling in the Aftermath of Storms

CHICAGO, April 10, 2012 – The <u>Robert R. McCormick Foundation</u> has teamed up with <u>WGN Radio</u>, <u>WGN-</u> <u>TV</u>, <u>Chicago Tribune</u> and <u>Vivelo Hoy</u> to raise money to help friends and neighbors in Illinois struggling with the damage, destruction and grief from the record-breaking storms that hit on Thursday, April 9.

The Illinois Tornado Relief Effort, a McCormick Foundation Campaign, will support nonprofit agencies providing disaster relief and recovery efforts to those communities hardest hit by the tornadoes. The McCormick Foundation will match the first \$500,000 raised at 50 cents on the dollar. All administrative costs will be paid, allowing 100 percent of all funds raised, plus the match, to be granted directly to nonprofit organizations helping those most affected by the storms. The first round of grants will distributed to community organizations helping with frontline relief efforts by early May 2015.
